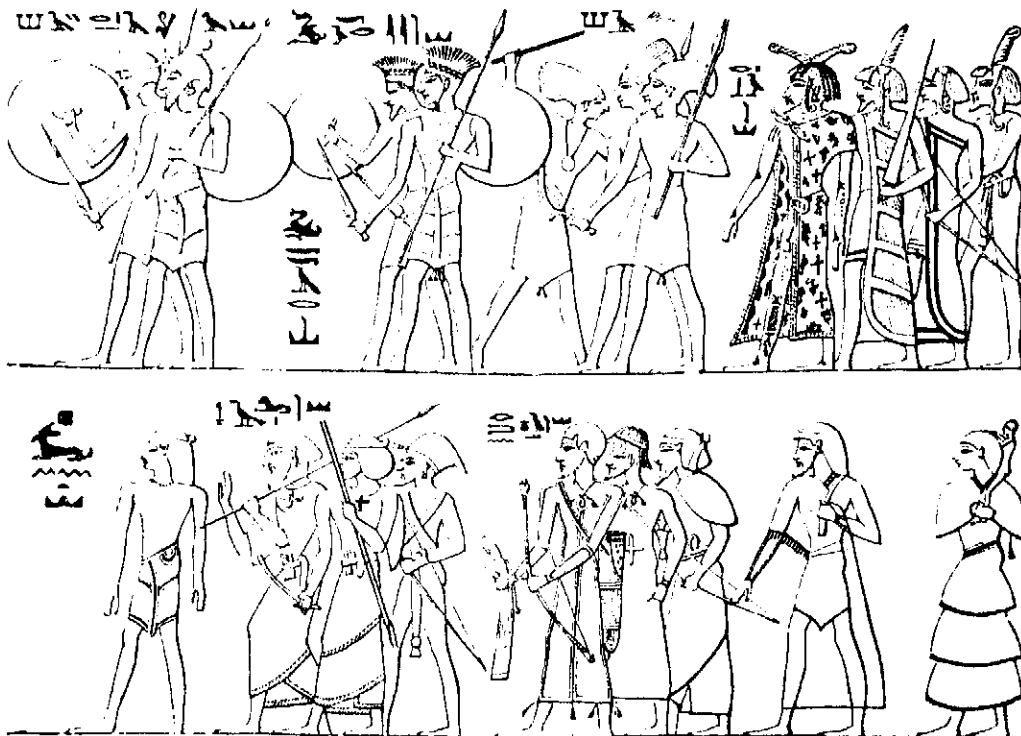

**King David** is a set of simple wargames rules; both fast and fun to play, using miniatures they simulate the battles fought by the great leaders of the Old Testament Era: Joshua, Saul, David and Solomon. With these rules you can even reconstruct the campaigns led by Ramses II or the epic Trojan War.

To play you will need a playing surface measuring 120x120cm, some scenery to decorate the battlefield and to make it more interesting, some 6-sided dice (D6), a tape-measure (in centimetres) and of course some 15mm Venexia Miniatures.
